Getting started
Setting up was easy. The instruction booklet was clear when it came to fitting the various attachments – and there were quite a few – for grating, slicing and blending. The machine felt solid on the surface, and safe, too, as it won't power on unless all attachments, jug and lid are locked in position.

What I made
I chose the mushroom soup from the recipes that came with the leaflet. It was delicious and simple to prepare. I used the grater, slicer, and both jugs for preparing the soup. Washing everything up was straightforward.

Verdict
This is a handy, time-saving gadget at a good price. The food processor would save you time no matter what the task. I would definitely buy one as it would allow me to tackle recipes I thought were too complicated, and of course it's always great to have homemade houmous and dips in minutes!

MUSHROOM SOUP
Serves 2
500ml veg stock
1 onion
230g mushrooms
30g butter or margarine
2 tbsp plain flour
50ml double cream
1 tbsp freshly chopped parsley or a few coriander leaves, for garnish
Salt and freshly ground black pepper



- Heat the stock. Grate the onion with the processor attachment. Slice the mushrooms. Melt the butter in a pan over a low heat, add the onion and cook until softened. Add the mushrooms and cook until lightly browned.
- Add the flour, stir for a few seconds, then add the hot stock and keep stirring until the soup thickens. Add the double cream and stir for 2 mins. Season and sprinkle with parsley or coriander.
